

11.9 JNNURM – Implementation of JNNURM – UIDSSMT – IHSDP in the state – Designation of state Nodal Agency – setting up of State level committee - Orders issued.

From the Joint Secretary and Mission Director, Urban Infrastructure and Governance, Government of India, Ministry of Urban Development, D.O.Letter No. 1/97/2004-UD-II dated 12.12.2005.

ORDER:

The Government of India has launched three new schemes for infrastructure development and provision of basic service in urban areas on 3.12.2005 viz.

- i. Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Mission (JNNURM) with 2 sub-components viz
 - a. Submission on Urban Infrastructure and Governances
 - b. Submission on Basic Service to the Urban Poor
- ii. Urban Infrastructure Development scheme for small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) and
- iii. Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP)

These three schemes will replace the erstwhile Mega City Programme (MCP) integrated Development of Small and Medium Towns (IDSMT) and National Slum Development Programme (NSDP) / VAMPAY Schemes respectively. Chennai (including local bodies in Chennai Metropolitan Area), Madurai and Coimbatore are to be covered under the JNNURM (both sub-missions). Other urban areas are in the state will be covered under the UIDSSMT and IHSDP.

2. Government of India have circulated the detailed guidelines for the above new schemes, under which state Governments are required to designate the State Level Nodal Agency which will deal with these schemes and also constitute various committees to priorities and appraise or recommend sub-projects under these scheme.

3. The Government after detailed examination, order as follows:-

- a) The Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited shall be the Nodal agency for the sub-mission on urban infrastructure and Governance under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) and for the Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for small and medium Towns (UIDSSMT)
- b) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration shall be the nodal agency for the sub-mission on basic services for the urban poor under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) and for Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP).

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- c) The Nodal agency viz, Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and infrastructure Development Corporation Limited and Commissioner of Municipal Administration shall be responsible for the following functions.
- Appraisal of projects submitted by Urban Local Bodies / Parastatal agencies.
 - Obtaining approval of State Level Steering Committee for seeking assistance from Central Government under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.
 - Management of grants received from Central and State Government.
 - Release of funds to Urban Local Bodies / Para – stata: agencies either as grant, or soft loan or grant cum loan.
 - Management of Revolving Fund.
 - Monitoring physical and financial progress of sanctioned projects.
 - Monitoring implementation of reform as agreed to under the Memorandum of Agreement (MoA)
- d) The Government also hereby constitute a state level steering co-ordination and monitoring committee for the purpose of recommending and monitoring schemes under JNNURM and IHSDP respectively, with the following composition.

The above committee shall perform the following functions:

- Examine and approve projects to be forwarded to Government of India for sanction.
- Periodically monitor the progress of sanctioned projects / schemes including funds mobilization from financial institutions.

- iii. Review the implementation of the scheme keeping in view its broad objectives and ensure that the programmes taken up are in accordance with the guidelines laid down.
 - iv. Review the progress of urban reforms being under taken by Urban Local Bodies implementing agencies.
- b) The Government also hereby constitute a state level sanction committee to sanction sub projects under the Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for small and medium towns (UIDSSMT) with the following composition.

1.	Secretary, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, Government of Tamil Nadu.	Chairman
2.	Secretary to Government, H & U.D. Department, Government of Tamil Nadu.	Member
3.	Secretary to Government, Finance Department, Government of Tamil Nadu.	Member
4.	Commissioner / Director of Town and Country Planning Government of Tamil Nadu.	Member
5.	Commissioner / Director of Municipal Administration	Member
6.	Commissioner / Director of Special Village Panchayats	Member
7.	Representative of Ministry of Urban Development , Government of India.	Member
8.	Representative of Town and Country Planning Organization, New Delhi	Member
9.	Chairman and Managing Director, TUFIDCO	Member and Secretary

The State Level Sanctioning Committee will perform the following functions:-

- i. Examine and approve projects reports submitted by the local bodies / implementing agencies including parastatal agencies, taking into account the appraisal reports. The Committee will assign higher priority to projects relating to water supply including sanitation, sewerage, solid waste management, road network and drainage.
- ii. Periodically monitor the progress of sanctioned projects / schemes including funds mobilization from financial institutions.
- iii. Review the implementation of the scheme keeping in view its broad objectives and ensure that the programmes taken up are in accordance with the guidelines laid down.
- iv. Review the progress of urban reforms being under taken by Urban Local Bodies / Parastatals / Implementing agencies.
