As per the existing instructions, the Government servants who were sponsored for the P.G. Degree Course at Government cost upto 6.5.85 were sanctioned advance increment.

- 2. Representations have been received for the sanction of advance increments to the Government Servants who are sponsored for acquiring post graduate degree at Government cost even now.
- 3. The matter has been carefully examined and it is found that there is no case for sanction of advance increment for passing Government sponsored P.G. courses.
- 4. I am, therefore, directed to state that Government servants are not eligible for the sanction of advance increment for passing Government sponsored courses and the instructions issued earlier in this regard continue to hold good.
