ORDER

In the Government order read above order have beed issued to the effect that the 1% vacancy, reserved in the teachings post of School Education Department be diverted to the deaf and dumb thereby bringing the reservation for the deaf and dumb in no teaching posts to 2%. The Government have decided to have the same method in the cost of similarly placed reaching and non reaching poste available in other department namely Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department (Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Schools), Social Welfare Department (Special Schools) and Backward Classes and Most Backward Classes Department (Backward Classes and Most Backward Classes Schools) and to issue amendment to the General Rules.

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

Notifications

In exercise of the power conferred by the Proviso to Article309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendements to the General Rules in part II of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules (Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manuel, 1987)

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the 26th September 2006.

Amendment

In the said Rules, in rule 22, in clause (aa)

- (i) in the second proviso the following sentence shall be added at the end namely
- "The shall however, be subject to the third proviso to the clause"
- (ii) after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted namely"

"Provided also that the teaching posts of School Education Department Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department, Social Welfare Department and Backward Classes and Most Backward Classes Department, other than orthopaedically physically handicapped, the reservation for the blind shall be two percent, and there shall be no reservation for the deaf. In the non teaching posts in the above Department, other than orthopaedically physically handicapped, the reservation for the deaf shall be two percent and there shall be no reservation for the blind".
