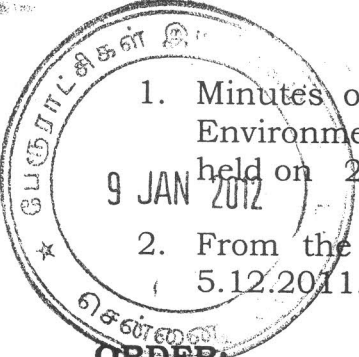

ORDER:-

In pursuance of the Governor's address for 2011 and as per the announcement made by the Hon'ble Finance Minister in his budget speech, a sum of Rs.50.00 crores (Rupees fifty crores only) has been provided in the budget for 2011-2012 for relaying of roads using plastic wastes collected in the local bodies. Proposals were received from the Commissionerate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Directorate of Town Panchayats, Commissionerate of Municipal Administration, Corporation of Chennai and State Highways Department and were placed before the Empowered Committee on Environmental Protection and Renewable Energy Development Fund in its second meeting held on 28.11.2011. The Empowered Committee resolved to approve the proposals submitted by the following departments and allocated Rs.50.00 crores as detailed below:-

The Director of Environment has now requested to release the above amount under Environmental Protection and Renewable Energy Development Fund.

2. The Government after careful consideration of the minutes of the Empowered Committee on Environmental Protection and Renewable Energy Development Fund and the proposal from the Director of Environment decided to accept the above proposal and to release a sum of Rs.50.00 crores (Rupees fifty crores only) for relaying of roads using plastic wastes collected in the localbodies as detailed below:-

4.	Corporation of Chennai	9.11crores (Rupees nine crores and eleven lakhs only)

3. The Government also direct that the implementing departments be requested to furnish the estimates for relaying of roads with plastic waste along with relevant Technical sanction and Administrative sanction from appropriate authorities and on receipt of the estimates, the Director of Environment will release the funds to the respective departments. The estimates should incorporate the details of roads that are proposed to be relaid using plastics, the length of the road to be relaid and the time period for completion. It should be ensured that all the works sanctioned must be only for relaying of roads with plastic wastes and necessary quality control measures must be undertaken by the concerned Departments. The implementing departments should complete this work on or before 31.3.2012 and to furnish Utilisation Certificate on completion of the work to the Department of Environment.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para-2 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No: 15-02:-

5425-00-Capital Outlay on other Scientific and Environmental Research - 208- Ecology and Environment - Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan - II State Plan - JB - Relaying of Roads using plastic wastes collected in local bodies - 16 - Major Works

5. The Director of Environment is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account opened at Para-4 above.

7. Necessary funds has been provided in Revised Estimate 2011-2012. However, the Director of Environment is requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2011-2012 at appropriate time to Finance Department without fail.

8. The Director of Environment is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para-2 above and disburse the same to the implementing departments.
