ORDER:

In pursuance of the announcement made by the Hon'ble Finance Minister in his budget speech, a sum of Rs.5.00 crores has been provided in the budget for 2011-2012 for conducting mass drive for clearing accumulated plastics. Proposals were received from the Commissionerate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Directorate of Town Panchayats, Commissionerate of Municipal Administration and Corporation of Chennai. The proposals were placed before the Empowered Committee on Environment Protection and Renewable Energy Development Fund in its second meeting held on 28.11.2011. The Empowered Committee resolved to approve the proposals submitted by various departments and allocated Rs.5.00 crores as detailed below:-

The Government also direct that the implementing departments are requested to furnish estimates for establishing plastic collection centres with relevant technical sanction and administrative sanction from appropriate The estimates should incorporate the number of shredding machines required, details of the packaging facilities proposed to be created and the location of the plastic collection centre. The implementing departments are requested to furnish estimates with relevant Technical sanction and Administration sanction from appropriate authorities for an effective 10 days intensive campaign covering all the sections of the society, especially school children for awareness campaign and IEC activities. receipt of the proposals as detailed above, the Director of Environment will release the funds to the respective departments. The implementing departments should complete this work before 31.3.2012 and to furnish an Utilisation Certificate on completion of the work to the Department of Environment.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para-2 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
