## ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have issued guidelines towards the utilization of grants recommended by the Thirteenth Finance Commission for Rural and Urban Local Bodies.

- 2) In the references second read above, Government of India have released a sum of Rs.3204.51 lakhs to urban local bodies as General Performance Grants forfeited by non-performing States for the year 2012-13 as per recommendation of Thirteenth Finance Commission.
- 3) In the references third and fourth read above, the State Government have released the General Performance Grants to Municipal Corporations, Municipalities, Grade-III municipalities and Town Panchayats under the Thirteenth Finance Commission for the year 2012-13 as detailed below:

- 4) As per the guidelines issued by Government of India in the letter first read above, among other things, the Local Body Grant must be transferred within the stipulated number of days i.e. five days of receipt from the Central Government in case of States with easily accessible banking infrastructure and ten days in case of States with inaccessible banking infrastructure. Any delay will require the State Government to release the instalment with interest, at the Bank rate of Reserve Bank of India for the number of days of delay. This would be applicable from the second instalment of 2010-11 onwards.
- 5) Based on the Government of India's guidelines and release of grant made by Government of India, the State Government have released funds to the local bodies and interest to be paid for delayed payment of grant to local bodies, are tabulated below:-

- 10) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is requested to disburse the amount to Corporation, Municipalities and Erstwhile Grade III Municipalities as per the amount mentioned in paragraph 6 above.
