### ORDER:

In the reference first cited, orders have been passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 18.04.2023 in C.P. (C) Diary No.6415 of 2021 and in other batch cases, in which the State Government was ordered to revise the seniority of the candidates directly recruited through TNPSC after 10.03.2003 on the basis of merit, as determined by TNPSC in the selection process itself and not on the basis of roster point.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the estimate of vacancy for the post of Class-II Officers in the Tamil Nadu State Treasuries and Accounts Service for the year 2021-2022 was fixed as 17 (Seventeen).

- 3. The pre-revised seniority (i.e.) roster method was in force, the regular panel of 17 Officers (Accounts Officers-12, Additional Treasury Officer 02 and Section Officers-03) in Treasuries and Accounts Department was drawn fit for promotion as Class-II for the year 2021-2022 in the reference third read above.
- 4. In continuation of the orders issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 18.04.2023, the entry level seniority has been revised as per merit list received from the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Based on the revised merit list, subsequent promotion to the first level for the post of Section Officer has been issued in the Government Order fourth read above.
- 5. In the reference fifth read above, the Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts has proposed to revise the panel for the post of Class-II Officers for the year 2021-2022 as per the revised merit base seniority list received from the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission by the Finance Department.
- 6. Now, the Government re-draws the regular panel of Section Officer (as per the seniority revised based on merit) fit for promotion to the post of Chief Accounts Officer in the Tamil Nadu Treasuries and Accounts department under Tamil Nadu Treasuries and Accounts State Service for the year 2021-2022 as below:
