ORDER:

In order to provide the right to citizens to secure information under the control of public authorities and with a view to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority, the Government of India have enacted The Right to Information Act, 2005 (Central Act 22 of 2005).

2. Under Section 5(1) of the said Act, the Government direct that Under Secretary (Estt.) to Government, Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department be appointed as a Public Information Officer to provide information to persons requesting for information under this Act in respect of Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department, Secretariat.

3. The Government also direct that Deputy Secretary (ADW) to Government, Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department, Chennai-9 be appointed as Appellate Authority to receive appeal from any person under section 19(1) of the Act.
