The Tamilnadu Livestock Development Agency an autonomous body, which would become a self-sustaining organization, designated to reinforce breeding activities in Cattle and Buffalo at State level was formed as State implementing Agency for the "National Project for cattle and Buffalo breeding".

The Agency has been registered by the Registrar of Society, Chennai on 11/02/2002 and started functioning from the **9**th **of January 2003**, with the Secretary to the Government of Tamilnadu, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Chennai as the Chairman of Tamilnadu livestock development agency and a senior technical officer as its Chief Executive Officer. vide GO Ms.No.18/AH&F dated 09/02/2002.

The objective of the agency includes bringing all the breedable female cattle and buffaloes under defined breeding programme through artificial insemination and natural service in a phased manner.

The TNLDA is performing the following to achieve the objectives along with the participating Agencies:

- 1. Implementing Livestock Breeding Policy,
- 2. Bull production,
- 3. Sire evaluation,
- 4. Semen production and distribution,
- 5. Liquid Nitrogen, Procurement,
- 6. Quality Assurance in all levels,
- 7. Training of professionals,
- 8. Training of Al workers,
- 9. Conversion of stationary AI centers into mobile AI centers,
- 10. Organising National Seminars, Calf Rallies
- 11. Creation of new Mobile AI centers through private AI workers in order to achieve the objectives of providing AI coverage at the doorstep of farmers for all the breedable female bovines, improve the conception rate, produce genetically superior progenies, conserve breeds and make necessary Institutional restructuring.

The Second phase of the national Programme for Cattle and Buffalo breeding is being implemented since 2006-07.

Under the second phase of the National Project for Cattle and Buffalo Breeding the Government of India released a sum of Rs.400/- lakhs in 2006-07 and Rs. 834.15 lakhs in 2007-08.


